- READ John 14:16, 17.
 - » Did roles change within the Godhead after the ascension of Christ?
- » Why is the Holy Spirit (seemingly) so much more active and accessible after Pentecost than before? Is it because God had successfully paid the "bill" for our sins and had purchased back the territory previously claimed by the enemy? Or was it something else?
