IT'S MY LIFE!

- As a child, how stubborn were you? What standoff do you remember the most?

PHARAOH'S NEW FORTRESS:

- READ Exodus 10:3-6.
- After admitting that he had sinned against God, Pharaoh constructs a last refuge—a castle in his own mind, where he can enthrone himself as the most powerful ruler, and if anybody tells him differently, he can simply deny it and say that the facts are untrue and no longer matter.
 - In verse 3, what does the Bible say Pharaoh's core problem is?
 - With the people in your life, how do you help people change from *proud* to *humble*? Has it worked?

GOD'S SECRET WEAPON:

- From this point forward, Pharaoh's pride will become God's primary target. From the 7th plague onward, Pharaoh will be deprived of the chance to give in, simply because of his own sense of self.
 - READ Exodus 10:7.
 - What do Pharaoh's servants see that Pharaoh cannot? What do they call it?
- READ Exodus 10:8-11.
 - How does Pharaoh's negotiation show his continued sense of pride?
